- This application and applicable fee are to be submitted to the relevant Maritime Safety Queensland Office.
 - If a drivers licence is unable to be produced, three (3) forms of personal identification will be required.
 - Buoy mooring authority holders are responsible for ensuring that the mooring device is maintained in a safe and serviceable condition at all times. Maritime Safety Queensland requires all authority holders to inspect the buoy mooring device annually to ensure it is in a good condition, in the position approved by Maritime Safety Queensland and adequate for securing the nominated ship/s.
 - The nominated ship/s should be attached to the mooring at all times unless in operation or at another location for repair/maintenance. Due to the increased demand for mooring space, a buoy mooring should not be unattended for a period of more than 90 days continuously without notifying the relevant Maritime Safety Queensland Office.
 - Buoy moorings are not to be provided to a third party for fee or reward.
 - Buoy mooring authorities are not for sale or transfer and must be used in accordance with the conditions placed on the authority.
